THE ISLAND

Guernsey is a self-governing British Crown dependency located in the English Channel 90 miles from the UK south coast and 60 miles from St Malo in France. At 21 miles square, we are the second largest of the Channel Islands and are known for our many beautiful beaches, coastal cliffs with stunning views, fantastic healthcare, great schools and of course our world-famous Guernsey cows. We have a population of approx. 66,000 people.

HEALTHCARE ON THE ISLAND

As we are not part of the UK, we fall outside the NHS. We are one of three privately owned Primary Care Practices in Guernsey with approx. one third of the island's population registered with each Practice. As patients are charged for medical care, we encourage them to take out private health insurance. The States of Guernsey provide some health cover for patients on income support.

Secondary care including in-patient treatment is provided by the Medical Specialist Group. This specialist care is provided to patients free of charge under a Contract with The States of Guernsey. Patients can also pay to be seen privately if they wish. There is a general hospital with an Emergency Department and an onsite mental health facility. We have a separately staffed Out of Hours service who cover nights, weekends and Bank Holidays.
